Invitation to Contribution of Articles

Submission of Article

Articles should be sent as email attachments to the editorial team at cms.rc@um.edu.mo.

For word documents, we only accept Microsoft word file format which should use Times New Roman font style, in a font size of 12 pt.

Images or illustrations, if any, should be of 300 dpi resolution, with source information and captions (sent as a separate email attachment).

If written in English, the articles should:

- have 5,000 to 10,000 words (and 1,000 to 1,500 words if it is a book review);
- use endnotes (sent as a separate email attachment);
- include an abstract, in English and Portuguese, of 150 to 250 words each, followed by a maximum of five key words (sent as a separate email attachment);
- include an author biography, in English and Portuguese, not exceeding 80 words each (sent as a separate email attachment);
- use traditional Chinese characters, if any;
- include notes and bibliography/references following the Chicago-Style formatting (sent as a separate email attachment);
- preferably use British spelling.

Copyright

Authors must warrant that the work and images/illustrations do not infringe any existing copyright. By submission of an article to the *RC*, the author indemnifies the publisher and editors against any breach of such warranty or copyright restrictions.

Material published in the *RC* may be reproduced, reprinted, translated, published as a collection, uploaded to the webpage of the Cultural Affairs Bureau for free access, without prior consent of the author.
